MEETING OF NOVEMBER 24th 1941.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

546th COUNCIL

The five hundred forty-sixth regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-fourth day of November 1941.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts; Councilmen Newman, Makin, Walden, Sperr, and Kemmerer; Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn, Marshal Rigdon, Police Officer Burbank, Attorney Adams, and Recorder Martin.

The minutes of the five hundred forty-fifth regular meeting of the Council held on the tenth day of November 1941, were read and approved as read.

*River Vista*  
It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Kemmerer that the street in River Vista Addition be referred to Mr. Milln, City Engineer, for his investigation and that he report to the Council his recommendation as to whether or not the Council should accept the street in its present condition. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mrs. Newman reported that the City Hall and Parks committee felt that \$100.00 per month for care of the City Hall lawn was more than the City could pay.

It was moved by Kemmerer and seconded by Newman that the proposed contract for a Franchise for Portland Gas and Coke Co. remain as it now is and that the proposed fee for said proposed Franchise be changed from 2% to 1% of the gross amount collected. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Boitano, of the Pacific Sanitary Service Co, appeared before the Council with regard to renewal of their Contract with the City.

The Mayor appointed the following committee to meet with Mr. Boitano and make a suitable agreement for garbage disposal in Milwaukie. Mr. Sperr, Mr. Walden, and Mr. Makin.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Walden that the Recorder be authorized to Clackamas County, taxes on Lot 18 Block 73 Minthorn Addition, in the amount of \$15.94, on behalf of Joe Bernard, provided he (Joe Bernard) advances the \$15.94 to the Recorder. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Makin and seconded by Walden that Mrs. Newman be authorized to purchase bone meal to be used on the City Hall lawn. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Newman and seconded by Makin that the Recorder be instructed to indorse the renewal for Liquor license for Safeway Store, Emil Kroll, Earnest McLaughlin, and Joe Gauger. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Makin that the Recorder be authorized to draw a warrant for one dollar (\$1.00) for State license for the City truck. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Makin that Mr. Bevington be authorized to purchase a stenciling set. Motion carried and so ordered.
