

MEETING OF OCTOBER 23, 1939

The four hundred ninety-ninth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 23rd day of October, 1939.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burdick.

Present. Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Gillem, Kirkpatrick, Mourer, Roberts and Rudder, Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Stanley, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

Ordinance Number 297, entitled "An Ordinance providing a tax levy on all taxable property within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for city purposes for the year One Thousand Nine Hundred Forty (1940)" was taken up for consideration, read for the first, second and third times and put on its passage with the following result being had: Ayes. Gillem, Kirkpatrick, Mourer, Roberts and Rudder. Nays. None. Ordinance Number 397 passed the Council.

Ordinance Number 398 entitled "An Ordinance providing the Council may dismiss City Employees for being absent from their employment without leave" was taken up for consideration and read for the first, second and third readings and put on its passage with the following result being had: Ayes: Gillem, Kirkpatrick, Mourer, Roberts and Rudder. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 398 passed the Council.

Mr. H. H. Moyer appeared before the Council in relation to building and establishing a Moving Picture Theatre in Milwaukie. He stated that it was his intention to commence construction of a building in sixty days.

Mrs. Rose Eckenberger and Mrs. Edith Hazen stated there was danger that WPA support to the library would be lost. The matter was referred to Councilman Rudder.

It was moved by Kirkpatrick and seconded by Rudder that the Council endorse the creation of United States Housing Authority by Congress and that such endorsement be conveyed to the Oregon Congressional delegation. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Roberts that the following bills be approved and that the Recorder be authorized and directed to issue warrants covering payment of the same.
