

MEETING OF NOVEMBER 22, 1943.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

593rd MEETING

The five hundred ninety-third regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-second day of November 1943.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts; Councilmen Newman, Bevington, Sperr McClure and Rowe, Water Superintendent Counsell, Fire Chief Fenton, and Recorder Martin. Absent: Treasurer Farrington.

The minutes of the five hundred ninety-second regular meeting of the Council held on the eighth day of November 1943, were read and approved as read.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that the Council recommend the application of Earnest McLaughlin for renewal for 1944 retail Beer Class "B" license. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Sperr that Mr. Hoggard be permitted to move a small building over the following route and streets in Milwaukie; from Lake Road on 34th to Wister, west to 32nd north to Oak, north-east to Monroe, east to 42nd. Motion carried and so ordered.

A communication from the Muchekilo Group of Campfire Girls was read and ordered filed.

The following committee was appointed to look over a building now under construction which threatens to be a nuisance Sperr, Newman, and Bevington.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Newman that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.

Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Newman and seconded by Sperr that supplies be purchased for the Fire Department and that a warrant be drawn for the payment of same, also that the Fire Chief be permitted to order a foam fire extinguisher for Milwaukie Lumber Co. to be paid for by Milwaukie Lumber Co. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Mayor brought before the Council the matter of Police salary. He stated that Mr. Shockley had reported that his car was more expensive to operate than he had anticipated and he therefore was asking an advance in pay. Mr. Shockley offered to work for \$225.00 per month and would furnish his own gasoline. After some discussion, and on the recommendation of the Mayor, it was decided that the Police salary be not increased.

The following citizens were selected to serve with the Council as members of a Planning Commission. J.C. Hinshaw, Harry Ray, J.M. Elder, Eunice Laxdal, J. Earl Jones, Chas. Kemmerer, S.F. Peake, A.W. Bertman, and J.F. Mourer. The Planning Commission will hold a meeting on December 6 at eight P.M. in the Council Chambers and the Recorder was instructed to notify the members to this effect.
