Town Hall Milwaukie, Oregon, December 3rd, 1918.

The two hundred and first regular meeting of the Town Council was held on the 3rd day of December, 1918. The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Snyder. Present, Mayor Snyder, councilmen, Shindler, Grasle, Miller and Bates and Seavey, Recorder Mathews, Treasurer Streib and Marshal Riley. The minutes of the regular meeting held on the 7th day of November, 1918, were read and approved as read. Councilman Miller reported that he had ordered an arc light installed at 32nd Street. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to write to the County Health Officer and request him to come to Milwaukie and inspect the unsanitary place in said Town. The Recorder and Treasurer were instructed to go to Oregon City and demand from the County Court the road money which is due the Town.
