MEETING OF DECEMBER 8, 1941.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

547th COUNCIL

The five hundred forty-seventh regular meeting of the Council was held on the eighth day of December 1941.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts; Councilmen Newman, Makin, Walden, Sperr and Kemmerer; Water superintendant Bevington, Marshal Rigdon, Officer Burbank, and Recorder Martin. Absent: Fire Chief Lewellyn, and Attorney Adams.

The minutes of the five hundred forty-sixth regular meeting of the Council held on the twenty-fourth day of November 1941 were read and approved as read.

A communication from Portland Gas and Coke Co. in which they suggest that the Ordinance covering a Franchise for them be laid on the table for thirty days in order that the matter could be further discussed, was read.

Mr. Boutano, of the Pacific Sanitary Service, appeared before the Council with an Ordinance covering rates and Franchise for garbage collection in Milwaukie and asked that the same be accepted. After hearing the Ordinance the Council agreed that it be tabled until the next regular meeting of the Council.

Mr. Boley presented a Plat of Boly's addition and asked that the same be accepted.

It was moved by Walden and seconded by Makin that the Plat of Boly's Addition be accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

City Engineer Milln appeared before the Council and stated he had looked at the street and bridge leading to River Vista. He stated that the bridge was sturdy enough for the loads it is expected to carry. Mr. Milln advised that the Council not accept the Plat unless the Plator agreed to maintain the Street and Bridge, and suggested that a committee be appointed to meet with Mr. Henry, of the First National Bank, Plators of River Vista. The Mayor appointed the following committee; Mr. Kemmerer, Mr. Sperr, and Mr. Walden.

A communication, from the Suburban Water Distributors Association, in which they advised that each District should immediately contact the County Sheriff, have Water Superintendant deputized, and establish a guard at all Water Department property, was read.

The Mayor appointed the following committee to arrange for a guard for the water tank and pump house. Mrs. Newman, Mr. Walden and Mr. Makin.

A communication from Mr. W.H. Hayden, of the Stanley Water District, was read.
