TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, DEC. 9TH. 1924.

The two hundred seventy-third regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 9th. day of December, 1924. Meeting called to order by Mayor Cowell. Present, Mayor Cowell, Councilmen Kerr, Miller, Kleeb and McIntyre, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The minutes of the two hundred seventy-second regular meeting of the Council held on the 11th day of November, 1924, and the minutes of the Council meetings held on the 21st day of November, 1924 and on the 3rd day of December, 1924, were read and approved as read. There being no objections made or filed against the acceptance of the improvement of Harvey Street, upon motion duly made and carried, the improvement of Harvey Street was accepted.

The proposed assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of Harvey Street was read, and upon motion duly made and carried, the 13th day of January, 1925, at the hour of 7:00 o'clock P. M. of said day was the time and the Council Chamber at the City Hall, Milwaukie, Oregon, was the place fixed and set for hearing objections to the proposed assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of Harvey Street. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to prepare an ordinance declaring and levying the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of Harvey Street, and post the same as required by the City Charter.

The Street Supt. was instructed to repair the streets that need repairing, but not to put any gravel on streets that had not been improved.
