COUNCIL CHAMBER'S January 9, 1939

The four hundred eightieth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 9th day of January, 1939.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burdick.

Present: Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Gillem, Kirkpatrick, Mourer, Roberts and Rudder, re-tiring Councilmen Dell and Ledding, Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Stanley, Fire Chief Lewellyn, Treasurer Wiseman and Recorder Adams.

The minutes of the four hundred seventy-ninth regular meetings of the Council held on the 12th day of December, 1938 were read and were approved as read.

Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Gillem, Kirkpatrick, Mourer and Rudder, Marshal Stanley, Treasurer Wiseman and Recorder Adams were each sworn in to their respective offices to which each was elected.

The Treasurers annual report for the year 1938 was read and ordered filed.

The Recorder presented his annual report of City business for the year 1938.

The matter of the application of Milwaukie Townsend Club for space in the new City Hall was taken up. It was moved by Kirkpatrick and seconded by Roberts that the rental charge to the Milwaukie Townsend Club be \$4.00 per occasion of use of quarters in the City Hall. Motion carried and so ordered.

Fred Rittenbach requested that he be charged city water rates. It was brought out that Mr. Rittenbach's property lies outside of the City Limits and that under the City ordinance he must be charged outside rates.

Harry Dean requested that the City put the streets in better condition.

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Kirkpatrick that Fred Bevington be employed as Water Superintendent and street Commissioner for the year 1939 at a salary of \$150.00 per month. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Roberts that the following bills be approved and that the Recorder issue warrants covering payment of the same.
