Moved by Councilman Knight seconded by Councilman Kelso that the report be accepted and placed on file.


Councilman Kelso called attention to the bond of the Treasurer and Marshall that the Treasurer refused to pay for his own bond. Considering that the Treasurer received no compensation for his work it was moved by Councilman Knight seconded by Councilman Lehman that the bond be paid for out of the general fund as ^{current} ~~general~~ expense.

The Mayor called attention to the notices of acceptance by the Engineer of Washington, Fourth and Oak Streets that these notices had been posted the required length of time.

Moved by Councilman Knight seconded by Councilman Kelso that the work on Washington, Fourth and Oak Streets be accepted in accordance with the recommendation of the Town Engineer. Carried.

Application for the improvement of Foster road came up at this time and it was suggested by Councilman Knight that a meeting of the property owners of Foster Road be called in the city hall on Jan. 18th at 8:30 P. M. for the purpose of discussing said improvements and taking the proper steps to adjust certain irregularities and differences as it now exists in the road that the Recorder be instructed to notify each property owner of said meeting.

No further business it was moved and seconded that we adjourn.

TOWN HALL MILWAUKIE, OREGON, January 18th, 1912.

Special meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie held January 18th, 1912. Meeting called to order by Mayor Streib. Roll call showed the following officers present:- Mayor Streib, Councilmen Knight Stockton and Lehman, Recorder Bolstad and Marshall Davis.

The Mayor stated the purpose of the meeting was to open bids for Monroe Street, transfer of the liquor license of A. C. Ullrich to E. T. Danna and to adjust and make final statement with the Coast Construction Company on their contract on Washington Street.

Bid for Monroe Street being opened and only one bid being submitted

the contract was awarded to W. H. Counsell for \$1062.80 less 5 % which would make it \$1012.80.

It was moved by Councilman Knight seconded by Councilman Lehman that the bid be accepted and the Mayor be authorized to enter into contract with Counsell for the improvement of Monroe Street.

Communication of E. T. Danna was next taken up for consideration, he having deposited the necessary amount with the Recorder (\$5) it was moved by Councilman Knight seconded by Councilman Stockton that the license of A.C.Ullrich be transferred to E. T. Danna and S. U. Germanetti.

A final estimate of the improvement of Washington Street performed by the Coast Construction Company showed a balance due for grading and macadam \$1588.34, due for cross walks \$122.44. And there is due from the Coast Construction Company for the use of the roller 9 days 9 hours at \$10.00 per day or \$99.00 to be deducted from \$122.44 leaving a balance of \$23.44

T. A. Mc Dougall, Manager of the Coast Construction Company, when being asked by the Mayor if he had any statement of his own, said, that he had none, but was perfectly satisfied to make settlement on the estimate of the Engineer and accept the figures as submitted.

The matter of imposing the penalty for the delay in completing the work was discussed. To adjust the matter it was moved by Councilman Knight seconded by Councilman Lehman that the Coast Construction Company be paid \$1488.34 as a final settlement of grading and macadam of Washington Street and \$122.44 less \$99 for cross walks. The motion being satisfactory to the Coast Construction Company was duly carried by unanimous vote.

No further business it was moved and seconded that we adjourn.
