Town Hall, Milwaukie, Oregon, January 6, 1920.

The Two Hundred fourteenth regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 6th day of January, 1920. Meeting called to order by Mayor Snyder. Present Mayor Snyder, councilmen, Grasle, Albee, Miller, Hart and Counsell, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Reed. The minutes of the 213 regular meeting held on the 2nd day of December, 1919, and the minutes of the special meeting of the Council held on the 8th day of December, 1919, were read and approved as read.

Mr. Counsell of the Street Committee reported that he had done nothing toward repairing the Streets on the account of bad weather, but that the streets were in need of repair and that he would repair them as soon as the weather would permit. The report of the Fire Commissioners recommending that the Town purchase a Chevrolet Truck for the Fire Department was read and upon motion duly made and carried the report was adopted and the Mayor and Recorder were instructed to order a Chevrolet truck for the Fire Department fully equipped for \$1825.00. The Report of the Treasurer was read and ordered placed on file. The petition to change the closing hours of the Pool Hall ordinance was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the petition was laid on the table. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Fire Chief was instructed to remodel the Fire Station in order to house the new Fire Truck.

The following bills were read and allowed by the Finance Committee and upon motion duly made and carried, the recorder was instructed to draw warrants in payment of the same:
