COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON JANUARY 28, 1935

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 28th day of January, 1935, for the purpose of considering bids for the sale of lots 7 and 8, block 28, Milwaukie, and for the further purpose of considering such other matters as might require the attention of the Council.

The recorder reported that he had advertised in the Milwaukie Review for bids relative to sale by the city of lots 7 and 8, block 28, Milwaukie, and that he had received no bids. It was moved by Wills and seconded by Burdick that the matter of the sale of the property in question be laid on the table until the next regular meeting. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Dean that Fred Bevington be hired to act as Water Superintendent and Street Commissioner for the year 1935. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Dean that C.D. Phillips be hired as city auditor for the year 1935. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dean and seconded by Burdick that the recorder send out questionnaires to all voters of Milwaukie asking them to express their wishes relative to the drilling of a test well in order to determine the feasibility of getting the city's water supply from wells. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Wills that an electrician be hired to install an electric light outside of the recorder's office. Motion carried and so ordered.

No further business coming before the meeting it was upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON FEBRUARY 11, 1935

The three hundred ninety-fourth regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the eleventh day of February, 1935.

Present: Councilmen Burdick, Dell, Sanders, and Wills,
Recorder Adams,
Marshal Wiley, and
Water Superintendent Bevington.

The meeting was called to order by Acting Mayor Sanders.

The minutes for the three hundred ninety-third regular meeting held on the fourteenth day of January, 1935, and of the special meetings held on the sixteenth day of January, 1935, and the twenty-eighth day of January, 1935, were each read and were each approved as read.

The Treasurer's report was read.

A communication from Fred Sperr offering to purchase lots 7 and 8, block 28, from the city for a price of \$3,000.00 was read. The recorder raised the question of the expense of securing title insurance. It was moved by Burdick, and seconded by Wills that the offer of Mr. Sperr be accepted providing Mr. Sperr would pay half of the title insurance cost. Motion carried and so ordered.

A communication from Charles S. Dean in which he tendered his resignation from the office of Councilman from Ward No. 1 was read. It was moved by Wills, seconded by Burdick that the resignation be accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.
