SPECIAL MEETING OF MARCH 3, 1952

The members of the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon met in special session at the City Hall, Milwaukie, Oregon at 8:00 P. M., March 3, 1952 for the specific purpose of discussing the proposed Street, Sewer and Water Dedication at Kellogg Park by the Public Housing Administration and any other lawful business that may come before them.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Fred Sperr and upon roll call those present and absent were as follows:

792nd MEETING
