It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Burgess, that Ordinance Number 1272 (AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, FROM R-7 ZONE TO A-2 ZONE, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1183, AS AMENDED) be read the first time.
