

## SPECIAL MEETING OF APRIL 11, 1957

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held, at the call of the Mayor, on the eleventh day of April, 1957

The meeting, which was called for the purpose of investigating and planning for certain improvements necessary to be made and such other business necessary to come before the Council at this time, was called to order by Mayor Mullan.

Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Clay, Mortensen, Roberts and Klein; and Manager Burdick. Absent: Attorney Sheldahl and Clerk Martin.

It was moved by Clay and seconded by Roberts that the Council instigate the proceedings for the following improvements:

1. Placing of curbs along Main Street extension
2. Grading and surfacing with black-top pavement, Main Street north of Milport Avenue to Beta Street.
3. Placing trunk line sewer along Main Street from Milport Avenue north to Beta Street thence east along Beta Street to Short St.
4. Placing an eight inch (8") water main along Beta Street from the twelve inch line at Mc Loughlin Blvd. easterly to connect with the eight inch line on Short Street.

ALSO, that the City Manager be authorized to call for bids for the following improvements.


1. Paving of Main Street extension
2. Paving of 34th Street, Quincy Addition
3. Placing storm sewers along 33rd, 34th and 35th Streets, Quincy Addition.

Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Clay and seconded by Roberts that a special election be held for the purpose of increasing the City Budget in excess of .6% and that the necessary proceedings be taken for this purpose.

Motion carried and so ordered.
