## SPECIAL MEETING OF APRIL 28, 1959

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie, was held on the twenty-eight day of April, 1959.

The meeting, which was held for the purpose of canvassing the votes of a special election, held on the twenty-seventh day of April, 1959, was called to order by Mayor Mullan.

Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Clay, Mortensen and Howard; City Manager Burdick and Clerk Martin. Absent: Councilman Sedgwick and Attorney Sheldahl.

## VOTES OF SPECIAL ELECTION CANVASSED.

The Mayor then announced that the Council would proceed with the canvass of the votes cast at the special city election held on the 27th day of April, 1959 for the purpose of submitting the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, the following question:

TAX LEVY EXCEEDING CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATION:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, be authorized and directed to include in the budget and levy a tax on all taxable property in the said city in the sum of \$24,078.00, for the fiscal year 1959-1960, for general city purposes, which sum exceeds the six percent limitation on taxation as set forth in Section 11, Article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon, and which sum shall be in addition to all other taxes levied"

The ballots cast at said election having been duly delivered to the City Council by the duly constituted Election Board, the Council proceeded to canvass the returns of the special city election which showed the following result.

Number of votes in favor of the measure	71
Number of votes against the measure	7
Number of votes rejected	none

Whereupon it was declared that the measure authorizing the City Council to levy a tax in the amount and manner as set forth above, had been approved, adopted and passed by the voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

It was moved by Councilman Howard and seconded by Councilman Clay that the Mayor issue his proclamation as to the results of the election as required by Ordinance No. 735, and that said proclamation be published in the manner required by said Ordinance and filed with the measure. Upon being put to a vote the motion carried unanimously by all of the Council present.

It was moved by Mortensen and seconded by Howard that the Board of Election be paid \$1.00 per hour for services rendered during the election. Motion carried and so ordered.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.

## MEETING OF MAY 11, 1959

## 934th MEETING

The nine hundred thirty-fourth regular meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the eleventh day of May, 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mullan.

Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Clay, Mortensen, Sedgwick and Howard; Manager Burdick, Attorney Sheldahl and Clerk Martin.

The minutes of the nine hundred thirty-third regular meeting of the Council, held on the thirteenth day of April, 1959, were approved as written.

The minutes of a Special meeting of the Council, held on the twenty-eight day of April, 1959, were approved as written.

Mr. Roy Jarman, representing the Waverly Heights Fire Protection District, came before the Council to discuss the question of fire protection being furnished them by the Milwaukie Fire Department. It was moved by Sedgwick and seconded by Howard that the Mayor be authorized to negotiate with the Board of Directors for the Waverly Heights Fire Protection District to provide fire protection to their District at an annual rate of five and one half percent ( $5\frac{1}{2}$ ) mills of the assessed valuation of the property in the District; the contract to contain other conditions as set forth in the City's contract with the Milwaukie Rural Fire Protection District and to be based on a five year time period. Motion carried and so ordered.
