

SPECIAL MEETING OF MAY 13, 1953

## COUNCIL CHAMBER

A special meeting of the Council was held, at the call of the Mayor, on the thirteenth day of May, 1953

The meeting, which was called for the purpose of acting on Ordinances numbered 581 and 582, and such other matters as were urgent at this time, was called to order by Mayor Mullan

Present were Mayor Mullan, Councilmen Shook, Clay, Klein and Wright; Manager Sperr, Attorney Kirkpatrick and Recorder Martin.

Ordinance Number 581 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Klein and seconded by Clay that the rules be suspended and that Ordinance 581 be read for its second reading at this time and that it be read by title only. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 581, AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 32nd STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARRISON STREET NORTH TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARVEY STREET, BY CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE EXISTS, AND WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR QUALITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, was taken up and read by title only for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result being had. Ayes: Mullan, Shook, Clay, Klein and Wright. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 581 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

Ordinance Number 582 was taken up and read in full for its first reading. It was moved by Wright and seconded by Shook that Ordinance Number 582 be read at this time for its second reading, and that it be read by title only, and that the rules be suspended. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 582 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 32nd STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ELMER STREET SOUTHERLY TO IST INTERSECTION WITH WISTER STREET, BY CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE NOW EXIST AND WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT GRADE OR QUALITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, was taken up and read for its second reading, by title only, and put on its passage with the following results being had. Ayes: Mullan, Shook, Clay, Klein and Wright. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 582 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
