SPECIAL MEETING OF MAY 3, 1965

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the third day of May, 1965, for the purpose of a hearing on the vacation of the south 36.79 feet of 25th Street in Ross Addition to Sellwood, and such other business necessary to be brought before the Council at this time.

The meeting was called to order by Councilman Robert Richmond.

Those present were Councilmen Robert Richmond, Donald Graf, Walter Freeman and Paul Slominski; City Manager Max Thompson; City Attorney George Van Bergen; City Recorder R. E. Osborne; City Engineer Wayne Daigle and Clerk Ellen Martin. Mayor George P. Haley entered the room soon after the opening of the hearing having been detained at another meeting, and took his place at the Council table.

Councilman Richmond opened the hearing on the vacation of the south 36.79 feet of 25th Street (Avenue) in Ross Addition to Sellwood and called for objection to the same. An objection was read in which the objection was stated that if this dead-end of the street were vacated there could be no utility pole placed in the street to serve electric power to Lots 1 and 3, Block 10 of said Addition.

It was shown that there were already utility poles at the corners of each of these lots and that no service of any kind would be shut off from these properties. The Mayor declared the hearing closed.

Ordinance Number 1071 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Graf and seconded by Slominski that Ordinance Number 1071 be passed to its second reading and that it be read at this time. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 1071 AN ORDINANCE vacating the south 36.79 feet of 25th Street (Avenue) in the Plat of Ross Addition to Sellwood was again taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result being had: Ayes: Graf, Richmond, Slominski, Freeman and Haley. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 1071 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.



Ordinance Number 1069 AN ORDINANCE to amend Number 614, was taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result: Ayes: Graf, Richmond, Slominski, Freeman and Haley. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 1069 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

Ordinance Number 1070 AN ORDINANCE to repeal Ordinances No. 14, No. 124, No. 161 as amended by No. 164, and No. 328; No. 492 as amended by No. 495, and 517, was taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result being had: Ayes: Graf, Richmond, Slominski, Freeman and Haley. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 1070 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

It was moved by Slominski and seconded by Freeman that the City sell the south 36.79 feet of 25th Street (Avenue) to John J. Galloway and Aileen R. Galloway, husband and wife, and that the Mayor be authorized to sign the deed. Motion carried and so ordered.
