
The City Manager was requested to inform Clackamas County of the city's position regarding Social Service agencies.

It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Hupp, to retain Frank Fairly as city auditor. Motion failed to pass.


It was moved by Burgess, seconded by Keller, that Cooper's, Lybrand & Ross be appointed city auditor. Motion carried and so ordered.
