

TOWN HALL MILWAUKIE OREGON MAY 29th 1912.

A special meeting of the council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the above date. Present Mayor Streib, Councilmen Kelso, Knight and Lehman, Recorder Goetz.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor who stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of acting on the improvement of the Foster Road.

The City Engineer furnished plans and specifications for the improvement of the Foster Road and estimates of the work to be done and the cost thereof, which plans, specifications and estimates were exhibited to the council, whereupon the council adopted the following resolution and ordered it to be posted as required by the Charter.

NO. 1-1912
Resolution and notice for the improvement of the Foster Road Milwaukie Oregon from the East side of Main Street to the West side of the Outfield Road. Whereas pursuant an order of the city council of Milwaukie Oregon heretofore made, the city engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an appropriate improvement according to the petition heretofore filed and for an improvement together with an estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and whereas such plans specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the council of said Milwaukie thereof :

The plans, specifications, and estimates are hereby approved and be it resolved that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its council to make said improvements, being described as follows towit:-

The street shall be brought to subgrade the full width thereof between the curbs on the roadbed hard surface shall be 16 feet wide down the center of the street, on the roadbed the hard surface shall be not less than 6 inches thick on the center of the street and tapering to 4 inches of macadam on the sides, and when completed the said street shall be brought to the established grade, with branches of the same *width* at all intersections with other streets, carried out to the side lines of the street under contract,

Said street shall be properly provided with all drains, catch basin gutters necessary to preserve the grades, imbankments and surface of the street, and to provide all proper drainage, crosswalks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications herein and approved by this resolution.

The city recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be posted as required by the city charter of Milwaukie, Oregon.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the council of Milwaukie Oregon at a special meeting held on the 29th day of May 1912.

The assessment roll for the cost of the improvement of Milwaukie and Sandy Road in the Town of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, from the north side line of Harrison Street to the west side line of Chicago Street was read and upon motion the said roll and Ordinance No. 72 Entitled AN Ordinance declaring the assessment of the improvement of Milwaukie and Sandy Road in the Town of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, from the north side line of Harrison Street to the west side line of Chicago Street were ordered posted and it was further ordered that the property owners subject to the assessment to be notified of the amount of the assessment levied against their property and that the council has set the 7 day of *July* 1912, at 8 P.M. at the town Hall as the time and place for hearing objections to the said assessments; and upon motion the said time and place were fixed by the Council for hearing said objections.

No further business moved and seconded that council adjourn. Carried.
