SPECIAL MEETING OF JUNE 29, 1956

A special meeting of the City Council of Milwaukie, was held, at the call of the Mayor, on the twenty-ninth day of June, 1956

The meeting, which was called for the purpose of a public hearing on the City budget for 1956-57, was called to order by Mayor Mullan.

Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Shook and Klein and Manager Burdick. Absent: Councilmen Clay and Perkins; Attorney Sheldahl and Recorder Martin.

The Mayor called for objections to the proposed City Budget for 1956-1957. There were no objections. It was moved by Klein and seconded by Shook that the 1956-57 Budget for the City of Milwaukie, be adopted. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 647 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Shook and seconded by Klein that Ordinance Number 647 be passed to its second reading. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Klein and seconded by Shook that \$4556.96 be transferred from Sewer Improvement Fund to the General Fund and that \$6720.94 be transferred from the Emergency Fund to the General Fund. Motion carried and so ordered.
