TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, JUNE THE 28TH. 1923.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 28th. day of June, 1923. Meeting called to order by Mayor Cowell. Present, Mayor Cowell, Councilmen Johnson, Kerr, Miller, McIntyre and Riley. Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The Mayor stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of taking up some matters concerning the different street improvements and the extension of 27th. Street, and for any other business that may properly come before the Council. Upon motion duly made and carried, Ordinance No. 194 was taken up for the first reading. The Ordinance being read the roll-call showed the following result: Ayes, Johnson, Kerr, Miller, McIntyre and Riley. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 194 passed the first reading. Upon motion duly made and carried, the rules were suspended and ordinance No. 194 was taken up for the second reading and read by title only. The Roll-call showed the following result: Ayes, Johnson, Kerr, Miller, McIntyre and Riley. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 194 passed the second reading. Upon motion duly made and carried, the rules were suspended and ordinance No. 194 was taken up for the third and final reading and read by title only. The Roll-call showed the following result: Ayes, Johnson, Kerr, Miller, McIntyre and Riley. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 194 passed the third and final reading.

A petition of owners of real property abutting upon 27th. Street requesting the Council to open, establish and extend said 27th. Street was read, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was read and adopted as read:

RESOLUTION

Whereas, certain owners of real property abutting on 27th. Street in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, have presented a petition, properly signed, to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, for the extension of 27th. Street in said Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from a point beginning at the intersection of the south line of Henneman's Acres with the center line of the present 27th Street, in said Henneman's Acres, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, thence south 0 degrees 24' east 639 feet, more or less; to a point in the north line of Lake Road, said point being north 0 degrees 24' east 31 feet, more or less, and south 57 degrees east 276.50, more or less, from the southwest corner of a tract of land, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, owned by Nettie Olsen, which property is described in deed from Gus Simon and Belle Simon to Nettie Olsen, and recorded in Book 98 on pages 113 and 114, Record of Deeds of Clackamas County, Oregon. Said extension of 27th street to be 50 feet in width for its

full length and to be a continuation of the present 27th. Street.

And, whereas, the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it necessary that said extension be made as petitioned for:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the City Engineer proceed, and he hereby is instructed and directed to make a survey of the proposed extension of 27th. Street, and to make a plat of the same, and a written report containing a full and complete description of said proposed extension and of the boundaries thereof, and the portions of each lot and tract of land to be appropriated therefor, and file the same with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon. Ordinance No. 195 entitled, "An ordinance providing for the improvement of 23rd. Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the south line of Washington Street, thence southerly to the north line of Young's Addition, and declaring an emergency," was read and ordered posted as required by the City Charter. Ordinance No. 196 entitled, "An ordinance establishing the grades on 23rd. Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the south line of Washington Street to the north line of Young's Addition," was read and ordered posted as required by the City Charter. Ordinance No. 197 entitled, "An ordinance establishing the grades on 42nd. Street," was read and ordered posted as required by the City Charter. Upon motion duly made and carried, the matter of allowing people living outside of the limits of the Town of Milwaukie to dump garbage at the dumps grounds in Milwaukie was left with the Marshal.

Moved and seconded that the Town pay for re-painting the Memorial Board on Milwaukie Highway. Motion carried. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to prepare an ordinance requiring all Railroad Companies to pave or plank their street crossings in the Town of Milwaukie. A petition requesting the Council to remove the Traffic Officer was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the recorder was instructed to place the same on file. Mr. Robbins was presented and requested to Council to lay a water pipe on 35th. & Harvey Street. The Water Supt. was requested to ascertain the cost of laying the water pipe as requested by Mr. Robbins. Mr. Holmes and Mr. Grasse were present and asked the Council if they were going to repair Lake Road. The Council advised Mr. Holmes that the Street would be repaired by the middle of next week. Mr. Riley made a motion that the Council purchase a repairing outfit to repair the streets. No second to motion. Mr. Cunningham was present and requested the Council to have the fence removed from Adams Street. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Marshal was instructed to remove all obstructions or fences from the streets of the Town of Milwaukie. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Council adjourned.

TOWN HALL MILWAUKIE, OREGON, JULY 10TH. 1923.

The two hundred fifty-sixth regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 10th day of July, 1923. Meeting called to order by Mayor Cowell. Present, Mayor Cowell, Councilmen, Miller, Kerr, Johnson, Riley and McIntyre, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The minutes of the two hundred fifty-fifth regular meeting of the Council held on the 12th day of June, 1923, and the minutes of the special meeting of the Council held on the 28th day of June, 1923. were read and approved as read. Mr. Viereck was present and asked the Council if it would pay him the cost of installing a water main to his property if after it was installed his property should be annexed to Milwaukie. No action was taken in the matter. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Council ordered all persons who desired Clackamas County to construct private driveways to deposit with the Recorder the sum of \$25.00 each to pay for the same. Upon motion duly made and carried, Councilman Riley was instructed to look after the patching and repairing Lake Road and Front Street and to have a thin layer of asphalt spread over the worst portions. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Mayor was instructed to purchase 3 monument boxes with covers. The report of the City Treasurer was read and ordered placed on file. Moved by Councilman Riley that the City Treasurer be required to re-imburse the Town in the amount of \$794.00, the same being the amount the Town had lost by reason of the Treasurer's failure to take up and pay outstanding bonds when he had money on hand in the different funds to do so. Motion duly seconded by Councilman McIntyre. Councilmen Riley and McIntyre voted for the motion, and Councilmen Johnson, Kerr and Miller voted against the motion. The motion lost. The application of P. W. Beasley to act as engineer on the proposed water reservoir was read and placed on file.

The Water Supt. reported that it would require 1200 feet of pipe to install the water main in Harvey Street as requested by Mr. Robbins and would cost about \$500.00. No further action was taken in the matter. Upon motion duly made and carried, Mr. Miller was instructed to deed lots 41 & 42 in Block 44, Minthorn Addition to G. C. Pelton upon the payment of the amount of the city liens against the same together with \$10.00. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to go to Oregon City and look over the records and see if Adam Street in Minthorn Addition is a city street.
