

SPECIAL MEETING

COUNCIL CHAMBER

AUGUST 15, 1961

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the fifteenth day of August, 1961, for the purpose of reading Ordinances Numbered 848 and 849.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Clay.

Present: Mayor Earl Clay; Councilmen James Howard, Charles Renard, E. H. Aebi and Theron Sedgwick; City Manager Leonard Mullan, City Attorney John O. Sheldahl and Clerk Ellen Martin.

Ordinance Number 848 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Howard and seconded by Aebi that Ordinance No. 848 be passed to its second reading and that it be read at this time. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 848 AN ORDINANCE declaring the assessment for the construction of sanitary sewers, trunk line sewers and connection laterals in GARNER ACRES, APPLEBY ACRES, THOMAS R. WEST SUBDIVISION, PLIMPTON TRACTS, ROCKWOOD ACRES, GLOVERLAND, ARDEN PARK and along GLOVER ROAD, and declaring an emergency, was taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following results being had: Ayes: Howard, Renard, Aebi, Sedgwick and Clay. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 848 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

Ordinance Number 849 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Sedgwick and seconded by Renard that Ordinance Number 849 be passed to its second reading and that it be read at this time. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 849 AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of 14th Street by asphaltic pavement, from 50 feet east of its intersection with 7th Avenue, easterly a distance of approximately 234 feet, and declaring an emergency, was again taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result being had. Ayes: Howard, Renard, Aebi, Sedgwick and Clay. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 849 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
