The meeting was called for the purpose of considering a resolution concerning a serial levy for street improvements.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 25-1972 - SERIAL LEVY FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS

It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Fuller, that Resolution Number 25-1972 (A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, A PROPOSAL PROVIDING FOR A SERIAL LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000, TO BE LEVIED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 PER ANNUM FOR EACH OF FIVE CONSECUTIVE YEARS, WHICH SHALL BE PAID FOR BY AN AD VALOREM TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, PROVIDING THAT SAID LEVY SHALL BE USED FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, AND DESIGNATING THE ELECTION AT WHICH SAID PROPOSAL SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON) be read. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Fuller, that Resolution 25-1972 be adopted. Motion carried and so ordered. *Councilman Hupp wished his vote to be recorded as "no." (see 9/11/72 minutes)*

The meeting adjourned at 6:35 p. m.
