SPECIAL MEETING OF OCTOBER 18, 1948

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held for the purpose of opening bids for the construction of sidewalks and curbs on 21st Street from Harrison to Jefferson Street, and such other business as was necessary to come before the Council at this time, was held on the eighteenth day of October 1948.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sperr.

Present: Mayor Sperr; Councilmen Nelson, Mortensen, and Hamlin; Manager Taber, Attorney Kirkpatrick. Absent: Councilman Frady.

Bids for the construction of curbs and sidewalks on 21st Street from Harrison Street to Jefferson Street were opened and read, the total amounts were as follows:

It was moved by Nelson and seconded by Hamlin that the Contract for the construction of curbs and sidewalk on 21st Street from Harrison to Jefferson Street be awarded to Smith Bros., provided their bid is found to be in order upon examination by the City Manager. Motion carried and so ordered.

A letter from Marie Thiessen with regard to a permit to use a loud speaker on an automobile for a short time was not read as the Council agreed that a special permit was not necessary under the circumstances.

Mr. and Mrs. Shaw, Mr. Price and Mr. Peters, residents of the Sellwood Gardens District, came before the Council with regard to the matter of the annexation of Sellwood Gardens to the City of Portland; which will be voted upon at the election on November 2nd. The residents of the district in question, invited the Council to attend a mass meeting to be held before the election. It was agreed that the members of the Council would attend the meeting.
