A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was called to order by Mayor Streib. Roll called showed the following officers present:- Mayor Streib, Councilmen Kelso, Lheman, Stockton, Knight. and Recorder Hanson.

Councilman Kelso read a written notice that the Recorder's Bond was cancelled.

Moved by Councilman Lehman and Seconded by Councilman Stockton that the Recorder's bond be increased from \$500 to \$2000. Carried.

Moved by Stockton seconded by Lehman that the Treasurer's bond be increased from \$1000 to \$2000. Carried.

On motion by Kelso seconded by Stockton the Treasurer and Recorder be given 15 days to furnish the bond as required. Carried.

Moved by Councilman Lehman seconded by Stockton that all money received by the Recorder be deposited daily in the First State Bank of Milwaukie in the name of the Town of Milwaukie. Carried.

On motion the meeting adjourned. Carried.

The City Engineer furnished plans, specifications and estimate of the cost of the improvement of Monroe Street from the east curb line of Front Street to the west line of Main Street of the work to be done and the cost thereof which plans and specifications and estimate were exhibited to the Council, whereupon the Council adopted the following resolution and ordered it posted as required by the charter.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the city Council of Milwaukie, Oregon heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an improvement <sup>of Monroe St. from the east curb line of Front St. to east line of Main St.</sup> according to the petition heretofore filled and for an improvement together with the estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and whereas such plans and specifications and estimations are satisfactory to the Council of the said Milwaukie thereof:

The plans, specifications, and estimations are hereby approved, and be it hereby resolved that the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its City Council to make the said improvements, being described as follows to-wit:-

The Street shall be brought to sub-grade the full width thereof between the curbs. On the road bed macadam, cobblestone foundation shall be not less than 9 inches thick on the center of the street and 7 inches at side when completed the said street shall be brought to the

established grade.

Said Street shall be properly provided with all drains, catch basins and gutters necessary to preserve the grades, imbankments and surfacr of street and to provide all proper drainage. Crosswalks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications herein and approved by this resolution.

Moved and seconded that we adjourn, Carried.

M. at the Town Hall as the time and place for hearing objections to the said assessments; and upon motion the said time and place were fixed by the Council for hearing said objections.
