

TOWN HALL MILWAUKIE, OREGON, NOVEMBER 7TH, 1912.

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the above named date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Streib. Present; Mayor Streib, councilmen Kelso, Knight, Lohman and Stockton and Recorder Mathews.

Mayor Streib stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the City election held on the 5th day of November, 1912. The ballots were duly canvassed with the following results;
