

TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, NOV. 26TH. 1923.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, was held on the above named date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Cowell. Present, Mayor Cowell, Councilmen Kerr, Kleeb and McIntyre and Recorder Mathews. The Mayor stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of levying a special tax for the year 1924, for city purposes. Upon motion duly made and carried, a special tax of \$7226.00 was levied against the taxable property within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, for the year 1924, in accordance with the City Budget heretofore approved by Clackamas County ~~Supervisor~~ Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission of the State of Oregon. Upon motion duly made and carried, the City Treasurer was instructed to take up and pay the outstanding improvement bond on Foster Road which becomes due in December, 1923, out of the Water Fund, and as soon as the assessments on Foster Road are paid in to return the money to the Water Fund, and if sufficient funds are not derived from that source, then the balance to be paid out of the general fund.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to notify Mr. Cliver that he must have 29th. & 23rd Streets completed ready for acceptance by December 4th. 1923.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the meeting adjourned.
