In 2009, Love won the Oregon Literary Arts' Stewart H. Holbrook Literary Legacy Award for his contributions to Oregon history and literature. He lives in South Beach with his dog and teaches English, photography, creative writing and journalism at Newport High School. He's latest book is *Of Walking in Rain*.
