TROLLEY TRAIL LANDSCAPING CHANGES

- Project staff discussed the revised landscaping plans at the Island Station neighborhood association meeting and again at the Milwaukie Monthly LRT meeting last month.
- As a result of the discussions, TriMet has further modified the plans to add additional large-canopy evergreen trees.



ROAD CLOSURES

- Each of the rail crossings in the City of Milwaukie will require full street closure
- The work effort will be performed 7 days a week within the allowed construction work hours but the streets will remain closed day and night.
- Local access to businesses and homes within the closure zone will be allowed.




WASHINGTON CLOSURE


- June 24th (Monday) thru June 30th (Sunday)
- Local access only between 21st Avenue and 25th Avenue
- Bus line (#29) to be rerouted.
- A sidewalk will be maintained on N side.

Washington & 21st closure




HARRISON CLOSURE

- July 8th (Monday) thru July 15th (Monday)
- Local access only between 21st Avenue and 28th Avenue
- Bus Lines (#28, #31, #75, #152) to be re-routed
- A sidewalk will be maintained on N side.

HARRISON BUS DETOUR

#28, #31, #75, 152

To be rerouted off Harrison between Hwy 224 and 21st Avenue to Washington Street instead.



MONROE STREET

CLOSURE FOR STORMLINE, STREET & RAIL CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS

- August 5th (Monday) thru August 25th (Sunday)
- Local access only between 21st Avenue and 25th Avenue
- A sidewalk will be maintained on N side



21ST AVE & ADAMS STREET

- Oct 21st (Monday) thru Nov 3rd (Sunday)
- Local access only on 21st between Washington St and Lake Road
- Lake Road to be open under the UPRR train structure but still height restricted (10' 6")
- Adams (West leg) to be closed permanently at 21st. Parking will be kept near Main St.
- A sidewalk will be maintained



KELLOGG BRIDGE GIRDERS

McLoughlin Blvd (Hwy 99E) between
Washington Street and 22nd Avenue
will be closed:

Friday, August 16th at 10 pm

thru

Monday August 19th at 5 am



HWY 99E PRIMARY DETOUR

- Southbound vehicles on McLoughlin will be directed to use Hwy 224 to continue south.
- Northbound vehicles will be directed at I-205 to use I-205 northbound to Hwy 224 to continue north.



SOUTHBOUND HWY 99E LOCAL DETOURS

- Soft Closure: 99E @ Harrison/17th – Right onto 17th to circle back to Hwy 224. Lefts onto Harrison will be allowed but not encouraged.
- Hard Closure: Southbound 99E @ Washington – Left onto Washington to proceed eastbound to Hwy 224.



NORTHBOUND HWY 99E

LOCAL DETOURS

- Soft Closure: 99E @ Oak Grove - Right onto Oak Grove Blvd – Left onto Oatfield Rd – Right onto Lake Rd to Hwy 224.
- 2nd Soft Closure: 99E @ Park Ave - Right onto Park Ave – Left onto Oatfield Rd – Right onto Lake Rd to Hwy 224.
- Hard Closure: 99E @ River/Bluebird – Left onto Bluebird – Left onto 22nd Ave to River Rd – Left onto Park Ave.



MCCLOUGHLIN BUS DETOUR ROUTES #33, #99 & #34

- Southbound busses leaving downtown Milwaukie will be redirected to:
 - 21st Avenue
 - Lake Road
 - Oatfield
 - Park Avenue
- Northbound busses will do this in reverse.



McLOUGHLIN PEDESTRIAN & BIKE DETOUR

Pedestrians and bikes will be detoured off McLoughlin (between Washington and Bluebird/River) to the existing path behind the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
