The meeting was called to order at 6:16 p.m.

Don asked if everyone had read the minutes from the previous meeting. Pepi wanted to clarify that the comment regarding blocking the entrance to the Winter Solstice was not PSAC's recommendation/decision. Pepi made a motion to accept the minutes. Ray seconded the motion. Agreed unanimously.

Fire – they're in the middle of budgets. Things have been fairly quiet lately. They've been working with Boring Fire on possibly merging.

Chief – 7125 SE Harmony Road – gave background on the situation at this vacant house/chronic nuisance.

We had a report of a missing eight year old girl this afternoon – she was located after we sent out a Code Red notification.

Last Friday while our photo radar van was deployed – one of our Sergeants saw an ODOT reader board with a message alerting drivers that the van was ahead.

Chief has written a letter to ODOT.

Active Shooter training for schools – North Clackamas, Gladstone and Oregon City school districts want this training so we will be working with them to provide it.

K-9 – Shaka has an issue with her knee. She may have to retire fairly soon.

There was a discussion regarding K-9's, training, etc.

We are working with County on the New Visions project. So far we have not had any issues with them.

The City Manager is going to ask the budget committee to amend the budget to include: for every adjudicated photo radar citation \$5 is going to go to the PD - \$2.50 for the training/equipment, \$2.50 will be for a community safety

assessment fund. Pepi made a motion to buy a new speed reader sign with the money that's already in the fund. Seconded and agreed unanimously.

Ray – Light Rail – regular Milwaukie meeting will be next Monday, 5:30, Tri-Met office on Beta Street. He's had reports of the construction lasting well into the evenings. His NDA is going to be writing a letter to Council regarding parking issues and possibly a permit system. There was a discussion regarding parking in the downtown area.

WSMP – Linda - there was a discussion regarding the list of projects, funds, priorities, etc. Members are to go back to their NDA's and go over their projects and determine if they want to go ahead with them and give Jason some direction. Linda will ask Jason for a report of remaining funds and projected costs.

School Safety Plans – Mary – the Superintendent is going to form a safety task force. She volunteered to serve on it.

Officer of the Year Dinner – will be held on March 27th.

K-9 fund raising – Sue – gave an update on fundraising efforts.
