The meeting was called to order at 6:20 p.m.

Don asked if everyone had read the minutes from the previous meeting. Pepi made a motion to accept the minutes. Chief seconded the motion. Agreed unanimously.

Fire – they have been collecting coats and blankets for the homeless. They will be distributing them this weekend. Operation Santa Claus is coming this weekend. The routes are on their website. It's the beginning of house fire season for them. He gave some safety tips.

Chief – he put the student working on the photo radar video in touch with the City's judge.

He has a request in to resolve the issues regarding the funds that were supposed to come to PSAC from the citations. The income from photo radar is double what the expectations were.

He talked about the issues with the homeless population in the City. The County is going to conduct a census. Last year there were approximately 8,400 in the area.

We will be having our first official visit from the Oregon Accreditation Alliance folks on Tuesday.

Tri-Met has a request for noise variance near River Road pending. They're going to close McLoughlin SB every day 'til 3:00 PM for five days. We don't know the dates yet. There will be an acoustical engineer recording the noise levels.

New Visions – have been licensed by DHS for six residents. He has asked that various parties who are affected be involved in some dialogue with them (school district, NDA's, etc.) and come up with a “good neighbor” agreement.

Pepi said she had two complaints regarding speed on Lake Road. Dave said he spoke with John Downey and he said they are aware of the complaints and are working in the area. Sue had a request from her NDA that they purchase a speed sign that is solar or battery powered.

Pepi had high school kids collecting pop bottles/cans for a fund raiser – she checked it out with the principal and they are legitimate.

Don asked if any NDA's have experienced issues with pedestrian crossings. Dave suggested giving specific issues/locations to Sgt. Marl and he will have the traffic folks address the concerns. Linda suggested sending an informational flyer out with the water bills.

Ray – Light Rail – there will be no December meeting in Milwaukie. Citizen's Advisory Committee will be meeting every other month starting in January.

Pepi – her NDA will be putting together safety kits next week.

Mary suggested that there be a spot on the City's website that lists all charities, fund raising efforts, etc. so that people can check.

Jory – they had a lock down at the high school last month. There was a report of a student armed with a handgun – turned out to be a large knife. The situation was resolved.

Joanne – they received the invoice for their crosswalk. Jason will attend the next meeting to discuss the future projects.

Ray – his NDA offered to pay for more brackets for the speed signs. They would like them placed at two more locations.

Sue - she and Susanna will be doing presentations soon year to raise funds for the K-9 program. There are also some grants that she's going to look into.

Linda – has four people lined up to help with the Safety Fair.

Officer of the Year Dinner – Dave Hedges will head it up, and several members volunteered to help. It will be held in March. Dave would like to ask the NDA's for contributions to help cover expenses.

There was a discussion regarding the plans for the Winter Solstice. They would like to block the entrance so no vehicles will have access – for safety reasons.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM.
