

ORDINANCE NO. 12 .

An ordinance making it unlawful for a minor to be on the streets after a certain hour.

Passed and Approved , 1905.

Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

That it shall be unlawful for any minor, under the age of sixteen years, to be or go abroad upon or wander about the streets of the city after the hour of eight o'clock, p.m., during the months of November, December, January, February and March, or after the hour of 9 o'clock p.m., during the remainder of the year, unless such minor shall be accompanied by his or her parents or guardian, said guardian being over the age of twenty-one years, or unless such minor shall have necessary business upon such street or streets. Any such minor who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof before the Mayor or Recorder of the city, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a term not exceeding fifty days.
