**Ordinance No. 2104**

**An ordinance of the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, amending the Milwaukie Municipal Code Title 20 Public Art (File # ZA-14-02).**

**WHEREAS**, the immediately previous and related ordinance repealed and replaced Milwaukie Municipal Code Section 19.304 Downtown Zones, replacing the previous five Downtown Zones (Downtown Storefront, Downtown Commercial, Downtown Office, Downtown Residential, and Downtown Open Space Zones) with two new zones (Downtown Mixed Use and Open Space Zones); and

**WHEREAS**, Milwaukie Municipal Code Subsection 20.04.050.A.1.a lists the previous Downtown Zones and needs to be updated to reflect the new zone names; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has prepared amendments to the Municipal Code to update that subsection; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the proposed amendment was posted as required 30 days in advance of the hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the amendments are in keeping with the previously adopted ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held a duly advertised public hearing on the establishment of Title 20, with notice provided per the requirements of the Milwaukie Municipal Code and Oregon Revised Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that these amendments should go into effect on the same date as the previously adopted ordinance amendments.

**Now, Therefore, the City of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:**

Section 1. Amendments. The Milwaukie Municipal Code Title 20 Public Art is amended as described in Exhibit A (underline/strikeout version) and Exhibit B (clean version).

Section 2. Effective Date. The amendments shall become effective 60 days from the date of adoption.

Read the first time on 8/18/15, and moved to second reading by 4:0 vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on 8/18/15.

Signed by the Mayor on 8/18/15.





##### 20.04.050 PUBLIC ART MURALS

###### A. Standards for Public Art Murals

###### 1. Allowed Locations
