

ORDINANCE NO. 29.

An Ordinance prohibiting the piling of wood or depositing of paper or any refuse matter upon the streets or walks within the town of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, and to provide for the cutting and removing of all grass, weeds and brush along the walks and streets and allies of said town of Milwaukie, and to provide penalty and punishment therefor.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, agent or employee of any person or persons or corporation, to place or pile any wood upon the side walk or streets or to pile any shingles or lumber of any kind or nature upon the walks or streets within the limits of the town of Milwaukie, for a longer period than 15 days, except as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Any person or persons, employee or agent of any corporation may upon making a proper showing to the Mayor and Council of said town of Milwaukie, that it is necessary for them to use said street or walks for a longer period than 15 days provided for in Section 1 of this Ordinance, obtain a permit signed by the Mayor and Council of said town for such further time as said Mayor and Council may in their discretion and judgment think proper.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, agent or corporation, owner or occupant of any property in the town of Milwaukie to deposit or permit to be deposited any brush, paper, shavings, dirt of any kind or nature, or any refuse matter, upon the streets or sidewalks within the town of Milwaukie.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any property owner in the town of Milwaukie, to permit grass to remain standing along any street or walk adjoining such persons property in the town of Milwaukie, during any part of the months of June, July, August or September of each year, or to permit brush or weeds to remain standing along the streets or walks adjoining such persons property at

any time. It is hereby made the duty of the city marshall of said town of Milwaukie to notify the property owners of the provision of said Section 4 of this Ordinance, and after said property owner has been so notified for a period of 10 days and said property owner has violated said section and failed to comply with the provisions thereof, the said city marshall shall immediately proceed to cause said grass, brush and weeds to be cut along the walks and streets adjoining said property and the expense therefor shall be charged up and become a lien upon the property of the property owner upon which said grass, weeds and brush has been cut.

Section 5. Any person or persons, agents, employee or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of the above ordinance, without having a permit as above provided for, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction before the city recorder of the town of Milwaukie, shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$50.
