ORDINANCE NO. 3.

An Ordinance providing for the Regulation of the use of the Streets, Alleys and sidewalks of the Town of Milwaukie:

Passed the 13 day of August, 1903.

The Town of Milwaukie does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or cause to be thrown or deposited upon any street, highway or alley, or grounds, or upon any private premises, or anywhere except at such places as are designated by the committee on health and police, and ashes, paper, manure, glass, metals, nails, broken ware, dirt, straw, hay, rubbish, garbage or other filth.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person owning property on any street, highway or alley in said Town to allow said street, highway or alley in front of his or her property to be unclean, and it is hereby made the duty of the Marshall to notify any or all of said persons to keep said street or alley clean, and on their failure to comply therewith, it shall be the duty of the said Marshall to have said street or alley cleaned at the expense of the owner of said property.

Section 3. Any person or persons violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder, shall be fined in any amount not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail ^{over twenty} for any term not exceeding fifty days or by both fine and imprisonment.
