


ORDINANCE NO 31

AN ORDINANCE VACATING MADISON STREET BETWEEN THE WEST LINE OF IRVING STREET AND THE EAST LINE OF MAIN STREET. THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all that part of Madison Street lying between the West line of Irving Street and the East line of Main Street in the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated and the dedication of said part of said street for use as a public street and highway, be and the same is hereby set aside and vacated as though the same had never been made.

Passed by the Council on the 8 day of March 1910. Approved by the Mayor this 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1910. *Philip Street*
