

ORDINANCE NO. 32

An Ordinance Establishing a permanent base of Grades for the Town of Milwaukie:

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the top of a certain cap screwed to a 2-inch gas pipe, embedded and anchored in a concrete base, the said base being eight inches in diameter and three feet in depth, and situate and established <sup>S. 81° 2' W. and 10 ft distant from the</sup> ~~at the exact~~ Northeast corner of Block Numbered Twelve as shown upon the original plat of the town of Milwaukie, the said Northeast Corner of Block No. 12, being identical with and being the same as the Northeast corner of the lots now owned by the Town of Milwaukie, and upon which is located the Town Hall to-wit, lots 3 and 4, Block 12.

Sec. 2. The top of the said cap is hereby declared to be One Hundred feet above datum, and all grades hereafter established within the corporate limits of the Town of Milwaukie for whatever purpose, shall be taken from, and have reference to the top of the cap above mentioned, and as the same is at this time established.
