

Providing for the establishment of permanent grades on Washington Street and its extension known as Oak Street, and also portions of Fourth Street in Sellwood's Addition as laid out and known as County Road No. 39.

THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the grades of the points named in said Washington Street and its extension known as Oak Street, and also portions of Fourth Street are hereby established as the heights thereof with reference to the city base of grades.

At the ~~xxxxxx~~ center of the intersection of Washington and Front Streets established at 96.00 feet.

At the center of the intersection of Washington and Main Streets one hundred ten and no/100 feet (110.00).

At the center of the intersection of Washington and Irving Streets 113.20 ft.

At a point 70 ft. east of the east line of Irving Street on Washington Street 115.20 ft.

At a point 120 ft. east of east line of Irving Street on Washington Street 115.20 ft.

At a point 317 ft. east of east line of Irving Street 121.50 ft.

At a point 357 ft. east of east line of Irving Street on Washington Street 122.00 ft.

At a point 640 ft. east of the east line of Irving Street 135.00 ft.

At a point 700 ft. east of the east line of Irving Street on Washington Street 135.60 ft.

At a point 890 ft. east of the east line of Irving Street on Washington Street 143.20 ft.

At the center of the intersection of Henneman Street with Washington Street, said grade shall be 145.40 ft.

At a point 1290 ft. east of the east line of Irving Street on Washington Street, said grade shall be 146.40 ft.
