

Providing for the licensing of plumbers and regulating the plumbing, ventilating and drainage of buildings.

THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Persons desiring to follow the vocation of plumbing within said Town of Milwaukie shall first secure a certificate of competency from the ^{health & water} ~~street~~ committee of the town council when upon the payment of one dollar ~~to~~ the Recorder of said town, a license shall issue to said party, which license shall entitle the holder to work at the said trade for the period of one year or for the balance of the current year to be named therein.

SECTION II. It shall be the duty of the said ^{health & water} ~~street~~ committee to carefully inspect all plumbing work or construction upon any and all buildings and pass upon the same for health purposes, and they have the power to call the Board of Health or the City Physician to their assistance for this purpose, and the further power to condemn and order to be taken out all plumbing which shall be considered unsanitary.

SECTION III. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to begin or perform any work on the construction or re-construction, alteration or repair of any plumbing or house drainage system or ventilating system or apparatus in any building or upon any premises in the Town of Milwaukie, whether he ^{or she} be the owner of such building or premises or not with out complying with all of the provisions of this ordinance in relation thereto and obtaining and having a permit so to do from the ^{health & water} ~~street~~ committee, which permit shall be exhibited while such work is in progress.

SECTION IV. All property owners desiring to construct new or remodel dwellings or ourbuildings, barns or any other structures in which plumbing, heating, ventilating or drainage pipes are used or are to be used, and for which cesspools are to be made or sewers connected to, shall, before beginning the said work, file with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie plans and specifications of the said work, which plans and specifications must be presented to the said

~~street~~ committee, approved by them and permit issued as in Section 3,
provided.

Health & Water
SECTION V. The ~~street~~ committee or the chairman thereof shall
at all reasonable times have a right to enter and inspect all build-
ings and premises for the purpose of ascertaining the condition there-
of and of the plumbing and drainage systems therein, and it shall be
unlawful for any person to hinder, obstruct or to interfere with or
molest the said committee or chairman thereof or any person he may
deputize while entering any building or making any such inspection.

(Providing that the same right and authority herein granted
shall be extended to and be the right and authority of the Health
Officer or City Physician of said Town of Milwaukee.)

Health & Water
SECTION VI. Whenever the said ~~street~~ committee or the Health
Officer or the City Physician upon inspection of any premises shall
find said premises or any buildings thereon or any part thereof un-
sanitary or unfit for human habitation and liable to endanger the
health of any occupant thereof, he shall immediately issue an order
requiring all persons to vacate said building, premises, or parts
thereof, such order shall be signed by the members of the street com-
mittee and shall be affixed and posted on the building or premises,
and wherever practicable shall be served upon the owners, lessee,
agent or occupant of such premises, and shall state the cause for such
vacation, and the repairs or alterations necessary to be made there-
on.

SECTION VII. It shall be unlawful for any person to fail, ne-
glect or refuse to comply with the order above specified within ten
days from the posting thereof.

SECTION VIII. Any person who violates, disobeys, omits, ne-
glects or refuses to comply with, or who resists or opposes the en-
forcement of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon con-
viction thereof in the Recorder's Court of said town, be fined in a
sum not exceeding \$ 50.00, or imprisoned not to exceed 30
days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court,
and every such person shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense

forevery day of such violation, disobedience, neglect or refusal and shall be subject to the penalty of this section for each and every separate offense.
