

ORDINANCE NO. 38

Providing for the establishment of Permanent grades for Harrison Street:

THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAINAAS FOLLOWS:

That the grades at the points named on said street are hereby established as the heights thereof with reference to the city base of grades:

At the intersection of Harrison Street and Front Street, 106⁵.00 ft.

At the intersection of Harrison Street and Main Street, 107.00 ft.

At the intersection of Harrison Street and Irving Street, 103.50ft

At the East line of City Hall lot, 100.00ft

At the intersection of Cherry Ave. and Harrison St. ~~100.50~~^{100.50} ft.

At a point 100 feet East of the Center of the intersection of Cherry Avenue and Harrison Street, 103.50 ft.

At a point twenty feet West of the center of the Beaverton & Willsburg Right of Way, 117.45 feet.

at a point twenty feet East of the center of the center of the Beaverton and Willsburg Right of Way,

At the center of Patton Ave and Harrison Street intersection, 143.00x ft. 117.45 feet

At a point 180 feet East of the center of the intersection of Patton Avenue and Harrison Street 149.50 ft.

At a point 453 feet East of the center of the intersection of Patton Avenue and Harrison Street 155.00 feet

At a point 151 feet West of the center of the S.P. Right-of-way on said Harrison Street, 157.40 feet

At a point 30 feet West of the center of the S.P. Right-of-way on Harrison Street, 162.40 feet

At a point 20 feet East of the center of the S.P. Right -of-way on Harrison Street 162.40 feet.

At a point 55 feet East of the center of the S.P. Right of Way on Harrison Street, 162.00 feet.

At the center of the intersection of Leo Street and Harrison Street 163.00 feet.

At a point 320 feet East of the Center of the intersection of Leo Street and Harrison Street 166.00 feet.

At a point 237.6 feet West of the Northeast Corner of the Lot Whitcomb D.L.C. 168.50 feet.
