

ORDINANCE NO. 382

AN ORDINANCE accepting the offer of the United States of America to the City of Milwaukie to aid by way of grant in financing the construction of a City Hall Building.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the offer of the United States of America to the City of Milwaukie to aid by way of grant in financing the construction of a City Hall Building, a copy of which offer reads as follows:

1. Subject to the Terms and Conditions (PWA Form No. 230) which are made a part hereof, the United States of America hereby offers to aid in financing the construction of a city hall building, (Herein called the "Project"), by making a grant to the City of Milwaukie, (herein called the "Applicant") in the amount of 45 percent of the cost of the Project upon completion, as determined by the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, but not to exceed, in any event, the sum of \$13,880.

2. By acceptance of this Offer the Applicant covenants to begin work on the Project as early as possible but in no event later than 10 weeks from the date of this Offer and to complete such Project with all practicable dispatch, and in any event within 7 months from the commencement of construction.
