

ORDINANCE NO. 43.

To provide for the improvement of Front Street by filling, surfacing the same with crushed rock, placing sidewalks and curbs thereon and making provision for sewer pipes thereunder.

THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Front Street shall be improved according to the petition of the property owners along the said street from the north line of Scott Street south to the southern limits of the corporation of Milwaukie, by grading the same with solid earth to the established grade, by surfacing the same with crushed rock and by placing thereon the entire length both sides wooden walks and wooden curbs,

SECTION II. That the cost of the said improvements and also the expense for the removal of any obstructions shall be assessed to each lot, tract, block, or right of way along the said street according as the City Engineer of said Town of Milwaukie shall determine, to the end that each lot, block, tract or right of way shall bear the burden of its own improvement.

SECTION III. That provision shall be made for the laying of sewer pipes through or under the said street at intervals to be designated by the City Engineer or the Council, either by laying the said pipes or suitable conduits for the same.

SECTION IV. That immediately upon the taking effect of this ordinance the Recorder shall notify the O. W. P. Company of its passage and the requirements therein, and also immediately advertise for bids for the improvement of said street as above specified, and all further procedure under this ordinance shall be in conformity with the provisions of Ordinance No. 39.

SECTION V. The width of the said street and of the sidewalks, parking and curb line thereon shall be determined by the City Engineer and shall be governed by the provisions of Ordinance No. 33.
