ORDINANCE No. 5

AN ORDINANCE providing for the assessment, levy and collection of Poll Taxes in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon. Passed April 14 1904.

The Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby assess, levy and ~~authorize~~ authorize the collection of a poll tax of \$2.00 upon each male inhabitant of Milwaukie, Oregon, not exempt by law for the year 1904.

Sec. 2. It shall be the duty of the Town Marshall to collect said poll tax so levied from each said person. In case any one fails or refuses to pay said tax upon request by the said Marshall, the said Marshall may proceed against him under the general laws of the state of Oregon for collection of Road Poll taxes.
