division 1 of section 22 of Chapter 234 of the Special Laws of the State of Oregon, enacted by the Twenty-third regular session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, and filed in the office of the Secretary of State, February 11th, 1905, entitled "An act to incorporate the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith, to-wit: "An act to incorporate the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, passed by the twenty-second regular session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, and approved by the Governor on February 4th, 1903, so as to provide for no levy of taxes on the taxable property within Milwaukie shall exceed one per centum per annum, also, for the adoption or rejection of an act entitled as follows: "A Bill for an act to amend Sections 3, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 15, and 16 of the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, and State of Oregon, so as to provide that elections shall be held biennially, and providing the qualification of electors of said Town, and the registration thereof, and providing the manner of nominating electors and officers of said Town, and providing for the division of the Town of Milwaukie into wards, also, for the adoption or rejection of an act entitled as follows: "A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter providing the manner of exercising the initiative and referendum powers within the Town of Milwaukie."

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a special City election shall be held within Milwaukie in Clackamas County, State of Oregon, on the 18th day of March, 1911, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of Milwaukie, for adoption or rejection the following entitled act: "A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter providing and authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to appropriate and condemn property within Milwaukie

and consumption of the Town of Milwaukie for the purpose of opening, laying out, and consuming thereof, who are authorized, widening, altering or extending streets, alleys, boulevards or rejection of the same in the Town of Milwaukie, to appoint viewers to assess benefits and damages, and to provide for an appeal therefrom to the Circuit Court of Clackamas County, State of Oregon; and providing for the rights of the owners of sewers or drains, or for any other such purposes, and authorizing the Council to do any and all other things necessary to carry out the purposes; and providing for an appeal from the viewers' report, and the time and manner of taking and conducting such appeal, trial, and all acts and costs on appeal, "also, for the adoption or rejection of an act entitled as follows; "A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, by enacting and authorizing an amendment to said Charter, providing for an authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to acquire, by arbitration, condemnation, water works and water sources, or to construct, keep, conduct, operate and maintain water works in said Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and to purchase and acquire Minthorne Springs, and possess real and personal property within and without the limits of said Town of Milwaukie for such purpose, and to issue and dispose of bonds and establish rules, regulations and rates for the use and consumption of water by said Town of Milwaukie and inhabitants thereof, to be supplied by said water works," also, for the adoption or rejection of an act entitled as follows: "A Bill for an act creating a Fire Department and Fire commission in the Town of Milwaukie, providing and amending subdivision 1 of Section 22 of Chapter 234 of the special laws of the State of Oregon, enacted by the Twenty-third session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, and filed in the office of the Secretary of State, February 11th, 1905, entitled, "An act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith, to-wit: "An act to incorporate the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, passed at the Twenty-second regular session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, and approved by the Governor on February 11th, 1903, so as to provide that no levy of taxes on the taxable property in Milwaukie shall exceed one per centum per annum," also,

for the adoption or rejection of an act entitled as follows: "A Bill for an act to amend Sections 3, 4, 6, 8, and 16 of the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, and State of Oregon, as to provide that elections shall be held biennially, and providing for the qualification of electors or said Town and the registration thereof, and providing the manner of nominating elective officers of said Town, and providing for the division of the Town of Milwaukie into wards, "also, for the adoption or rejection of an act entitled as follows: " A Bill for an act to amend the charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter providing the manner of exercising the initiative and referendum powers within the Town of Milwaukie." Section 2. That such election shall be held and conducted and the vote canvassed and the returns made in all respects as required by law.
