

ORDINANCE NO. 2056

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON,
AMENDING MILWAUKIE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.11.020 TO REVISE THE
QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENS UTILITY ADVISORY BOARD.**

WHEREAS, Milwaukie Municipal Code Chapter 2.11.020 specifies membership qualifications for individuals appointed to serve as citizen members of the Citizens Utility Advisory Board (CUAB), and

WHEREAS, the MMC 2.11.020 requires that CUAB members “be either Milwaukie residents or own a business within the City limits throughout their term. (Ord. 1875 § 1, 2000: Ord. 1798 § 1 (part), 1996)”, and

WHEREAS, there are households who receive water or wastewater services provided by the City of Milwaukie and are ratepayers to the City yet do not live within the City limits, and

WHEREAS, the Council agrees the CUAB should be comprised of ratepayers and desires to amend the board qualifications to allow for non-resident ratepayers to serve as members.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

Chapter 2.11.020 of the Milwaukie Municipal Code is amended to read:

The Board shall consist of five (5) members appointed at large by the Mayor with consent of the Council, all of whom must be either Milwaukie residents, own a business within the City limits, or reside outside city limits but is a ratepayer served by a Milwaukie utility (water or wastewater) throughout their term. (Ord. 1875 § 1, 2000: Ord. 1798 § 1 (part), 1996)

Read the first time on 1/15/13, and moved to second reading by 5-0 vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on 1/15/13
