ORDINANCE NO. 103.  
(Cont'd)

Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to give or send any false fire alarm, or in any manner interfere with the fire signals or bells.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to set out fires within the Town of Milwaukee without first having a permit from the chief of the Fire Department.

3. Any person or persons violating the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars, or by imprisonment for a period of not less than two days nor more than Twenty-five days, or by both a fine and imprisonment.

4. Any person or persons violating the provisions of section 2 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars.

5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
