

ORDINANCE NUMBER 104.

An ordinance providing for the cleaning up of lots and yards within the Town of Milwaukee, which constitutes a fire menace; providing for passage ways in all theaters operating in said Town, and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

MILWAUKEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. If any person or persons, owning or occupying any lot or tract of land within the corporate limits of the Town of Milwaukee, shall fail or refuse to remove therefrom, within 15 days after being notified to do so by the Fire Commission, any material, rubbish or refuse matter which constitutes a fire menace, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars and not more than Fifteen Dollars.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any owner, lessee or other person to operate a theater within the Town of Milwaukee without first having provided said theater with one main aisle of not less than four (4) feet in width running the entire length of the theater and connecting with the main entrance or exit, which entrance or exit shall be as wide as the aisle. And it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to place any obstruction in said aisle or otherwise blockade the same so as to prevent the free passage thereof.

Section 3. If any person or persons shall violate the provisions of Section 2 of this ordinance he or she shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars.
