

ORDINANCE NUMBER 106.

An ordinance amending section 4 of ordinance number 98, entitled, " An ordinance to license, tax, regulate and restrain bar-rooms, roadhouses, drinking shops or other places where spirituous, vinous or malted liquors are sold, or kept for sale, or in any manner disposed of, and to regulate the disposal of the same; to define the duties and responsibilities of saloon-keepers, bartenders and all dealers in spirituous, malt or vinous liquors, and for the repeal of Ordinance no. 69, and providing a punishment for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

MILWAUKIE DOFS ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 4 of Ordinance No. 98 be and the is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Every person to whom a license is granted and before the same shall be issued, shall pay into the Treasury of the Town of Milwaukie at the date when the said license is granted, and on the first of each and every quarter^r thereafter, the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars per quarter, and every license for which the said quarterly payment shall not be made within three days of the first day of the said quarter for which the said payment is due and payable, shall be considered null and void, and revoked without further action on the part of the Council, and every act of the holder of said license to operate thereunder after the expiration of the said third day shall be, and is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor and punishable as provided herein for the other violations hereof. The first quarter shall begin on the first day of January, and end with the 31st day of March. The second quarter shall begin on the first day of April and end on the 30th day of June. The third quarter shall begin on the first day of July and end on the 30th day of September, and the last or fourth quarter shall begin on the first day of October

and end on the 31st day of December. The fee for the licenses granted any time between the first and the last day of any quarter shall be pro rata and payable as aforesaid. Provided, however, that any grocerer, store-keeper or other person or persons selling or in any manner disposing of intoxicating liquors in the original packages and not to be drunk on the premises shall pay to the Treasurer of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, an annual license fee of \$400.00 per annum, to be paid at the time and in the manner above setforth.

Section 2. Inasmuch as there is no ordinance regulating the licensing of grocerers, Store-keepers or other persons selling or disposing of intoxicating liquors in the original packages and as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety that such an ordinance be passed: An emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor. Posted this 15th day of April, 1914.
