

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1114

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PROCEDURE TO ANNEX, WITHOUT ELECTION, CERTAIN TERRITORY, CONTINGUOUS TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, FIXING A DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ON THE QUESTION OF SUCH ANNEXATION, DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The consent of JAMES J. ANDERSON and LOIS J. ANDERSON, husband and wife, to the ANNEXATION OF THE FOLLOWING TERRITORY:

Situated in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, beginning at the Southeast corner of Block 22, MINTHORN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PORTLAND; running thence South on the West line of Sheridan Street, presently known as Stanley Avenue, 160 feet to the middle line of Block 35 in said addition; thence West parallel with the North line of said Block 35, 305.00 feet; thence North parallel with the West line of Sheridan Street 160 feet to the South line of said Block 22; thence East along the South line of said Block 22, 305.00 feet to the place of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM: the South 90 feet of the East 135 feet. Said excepted parcel having been conveyed to Kenneth D. Whitney, et ux, by deed recorded in Clackamas County Deed Book 660, at page 394.

TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, and of which they are the sole owners of record of the tracts comprising the said territory set forth in their consent in writing, said territory being contiguous to the present boundary of the City of Milwaukie and situated in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby elect to dispense with submitting the question of the annexation of this territory to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, hereby fixes the 23rd day of May, 1966, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock, p. m., PDT, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, at which time and place the registered voters of said City may appear and be heard upon the question of such annexation.

Section 4. That notice of such time and place of such hearing be published in the Milwaukie Review, a newspaper of general circulation in Milwaukie, Oregon, once each week for two successive weeks prior to the said date fixed for public hearing, and that the City Recorder cause public notice to be posted in four public places within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, said notice to show the time and place of said public hearing and be posted a like period of time.

Section 5. Inasmuch as this ordinance is immediately necessary for the preservation of public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon,



and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that the result of the enactment of this ordinance will be to place valuable and extensive property upon the tax rolls, provide the City with new sources of revenues, accelerate sanitary development and preserve the public credit, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.


