

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1123

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY SURROUNDED BY THE CORPORATE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF OREGON REVISED STATUTES, CHAPTER 222, AS AMENDED BY 1963 OREGON LAWS, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH ANNEXATION.

The City of Milwaukie Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, by and through its legislative body does annex the following territory, presently surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, as follows:

A portion of the J. D. Garrett D. L. C. described as follows: Beginning at a point 387.12 feet West, 2184.03 feet South of the Northeast corner of the J. D. Garrett D. L. C. , in Sections 31 and 32, T1S, R2E, of the W. M. ; thence West 108.39 feet; thence South 97.72 feet; thence East 108.39 feet; thence North 97.72 feet to the place of beginning: EXCEPTING therefrom the East 10 feet of even width, and TOGETHER with an easement for roadway purposes over said East 10 feet, in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon.

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Milwaukie does hereby elect to dispense with and hereby does dispense with submitting the question of the annexation of said surrounded territory to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 3. That the owner of said surrounded territory is as follows: DAVID D. BROWN and ROBERTA C. BROWN, husband and wife.

Section 4. The City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of State, of the State of Oregon, a copy of this Ordinance, and to transmit further copies of said documents to the County Assessor, the County Clerk and the County Surveyor of the County of Clackamas, Oregon.


