 final payment. No proposal shall be considered when not accompanied by force and effect
 a certified check of 5% of the total estimate, drawn to the order of this 25th day of

 Town upon the failure of the successful bidder to execute the agreement by the Mayor
 provided for herein, within ten days after the award of the Contract by D. P. Mathews
 Section 3. Blank forms upon which all proposals are submitted will
 furnished upon application to the Town Engineer. Upon the acceptance
 said improvement and after the assessment therefor is made and deposited
 the Mayor and Recorder shall draw warrants on the fund created for
 improvement, and in favor of the party entitled thereto.

Section 4. The Contractor will be required to furnish bonds with
 ed security in the sum of \$1,000.00, considered upon the faithful
 mance of the work in accordance with all the stipulations of the
 within the time named therein.

Section 5. Whenever the word "Engineer" is named in said contract
 understood to refer to the Town Engineer employed and authorized
 Council to superintend such work.

Section 6. Whenever the word "Contractor" occurs in said contract
 specifications, it is understood to refer to the Contractor or firm
 firm of Contractors or any member thereof, or any Contractor under
 the work herein specified. All the work and material to be furnished
 shall be done and furnished to the satisfaction of the Town Engineer
 The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Section 7. The said contract shall contain a stipulation to the effect
 that the person, firm or corporation to whom the said contract is
 shall look for the payment only to the sum assessed upon the property
 liable to pay such improvement and collected and paid into the Town
 Treasury for that purpose, and they will not require Milwaukie, Oregon,
 legal process or otherwise, to pay the said sum out of any other
 funds.
